1 The first book I wrote, Theophilus, concerned all that Jesus began to do and teach, until the day in which he was received up, after he had given the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. 3 To these he also showed himself alive after he suffered, by many proofs, appearing to them over a period of forty days and speaking about God's Kingdom.

4 Being assembled together with them, he commanded them, "Do not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which you have heard me say." 5 For John, indeed, was baptised in water, but you will be baptised in the Holy Spirit, and many days from now.
