A nd she will not hold a ⁵ blasphemer guiltless for his lips;

B ecause God beareth witness of his reins,

A nd is a true overseer of his heart,

 - B ecause no secret utterance shall go on its way void,
 - A nd a mouth that belieth destroyeth a soul.

12Court not death in the error of your life;

N either draw upon yourselves destruction by the works of your hands:

N either delighteth he when the living perish:
